Nine states were represented as 210 producers attended McBee's SELECTION DAY 2009. Buyers were active as 44% of the bulls went to new buyers and 56% were taken by repeat customers. Top selling bull was a fullblood bull, MCB MR 440P 8018, going to repeat buyer Bean Cattle Company, Stevenson, AL., at \$3500 for ½ interest. Second high selling purebred bull was MCB MR 396N 7114 at \$2500 for ½ interest. He was purchased by commercial producer, Cobb Farms, Columbia, MO. Three Braunvieh/Angus Hybrid bulls sold for a \$5000 valuation with MCBEEF BUILDER F2 7659 and MCBEEF BUILDER F1 7612 going to repeat buyer Weimer Farms, Salisbury, MO., and MCBEEF BUILDER F1 8521 going to Cutting Edge Genetics, Lowry City, MO.

The top selling females were two purebred first calf pairs, MCB MS 118P 7017 with heifer calf at \$2875 and MCB FF MS 6193 7201 with heifer calf at \$2775 going to new customer Mike Simon, Sedalia, MO. Volume buyers were Bean Cattle Company, Stevenson, AL with 3 fullblood bulls and 1 Hybrid pair and McCutchin Ranches, Aubrey, TX., 4 PB bulls and 4 PB pairs.
