A nice sunny day greeted the visitors to the 7th Annual McBee SELECTION DAY held at the ranch at Fayette, Missouri, on April 17, 2010. Buyers participated and took 55 lots home to eight states. Bidding was active as 47% of the cattle went to new customers and repeat customers took home 53% of the Purebred/Fullblood Braunvieh and McBeef Builder Hybrid bulls and females.

Top selling bull was MCBEEF BUILDER F2 8549, a polled 2nd generation hybrid with good ratios and EPD's across the board. going to Rob Bodine, Voltaire, ND, for \$5400. The next two high sellers were also Hybrids with one half interest in MCBEEF BUILDER F1 9538, a high growth 1st generation polled bull with a 126 MGR, taken by Tim Cobb, Missouri at a \$4900 valuation and MCBEEF BUILDER F1 9556, another above average ratioed polled bull going to Kruse Farms, Missouri at \$4000. Two McBeef Builder Hybrid bulls sold for \$2700, with MCBEEF BUILDER F2 8544, going to longtime commercial customer Haeffner LLC, Missouri, and MCBEEF BUILDER F1 9520 selected by new customer, Michael Owen, Missouri.

MCB MR F020 8115 was the top selling whole bull from the Purebred/Fullblood offering. He was a son of KWC QUINTO F020 out of a C102 daughter with good numbers and performance, selling to new customers Terry & Mary Hash, Arkansas, at \$3200. Two purebred bulls brought \$2600 with MCB MR 28P 8122, a polled 28P son with a IMF ratio of 123 going to new customer Estelle Jones, Tennessee, and MCB MR 506R 8132 a top son of the 506R bull going to new customer Stovall Farms, Mississippi.

Top selling Purebred Braunvieh pair was MCB MS 440P 8030, a polled daughter of 440P with a Polled Plus heifer calf at side going to repeat buyers Mike & Joy Simon, Missouri, for \$2100. High selling McBeef Builder Hybrid pair was MCBEEF BUILDER F1 8524, an F1 cow with an F2 heifer calf by the 6700 bull at side for \$1925. She was selected by new customer Mike Owen, Missouri. New female customers, Ruth Schneider and J.D. Brown, Missouri, selected a polled F2, MCBEEF BUILDER F2 8505, as the high selling Hybrid bred heifer at \$1400. Top Purebred open heifer was MCB MS H106 8110, for \$1050, going to Ed Taylor, Kansas, and the top McBeef Builder Hybrid open heifer, MCBEEF BUILDER F1 9566, went to Junior member, Lindsey Lichtenegger, Missouri, for \$1175.

Volume buyers were Stovall Farms, Mississippi, with 3 Purebred bulls, Estelle Jones, Tennessee, with 2 Purebred bulls, Schneider and Brown, Missouri, with 3 Purebred and Hybrid females, Michael Owen, Missouri, with 2 Purebred and Hybrid females and 1 Hybrid bull and Ed Taylor, Kansas, with 3 Purebred females.
