McBee Cattle Company's 12th Annual SELECTION DAY Sale was held April 18, 2015, at the ranch, Fayette, MO. It was a beautiful day, the lunch room was packed and Braunvieh and Braunvieh Angus Hybrid bulls and females went to buyers from 13 states.

Top selling Braunvieh bulls were Lot 101, MCB MR 304W 105P 3111, a polled son of VISTA 4Z 304W ET out of a Fullblood C102 daughter going to a partnership of repeat buyer Bodine Farms, North Dakota, and new buyer Bear Lake Braunvieh, Wisconsin, for \$7,500. Lots 100 and 102, two more sons of 304W went to new buyers, Missouri Valley Commission Company and repeat customer, Boulden Farms, Missouri, for \$5000 each. MVCC is where the McBee Calf Roundup cattle are gathered, grouped and sold. New buyer, Robert Eades, Arkansas, purchased MCB MR 7L 56N 3110, a linebred son of Polled Precision 7L, for \$4750.

The McBeef Builder Hybrid bulls were well sought after again this year, with the top selling whole bull going to repeat customers, Shane and Marlene Cook of Kansas. He was Lot 163, MCBEEF BUILDER F2 474P 3626 at \$5700. Repeat buyer, Olson Ranch, Kansas, took home 2 top selling bulls, Lot 153, MCBEEF BUILDER F2 474P 3629 and Lot 176, MCBEEF BUILDER F1 825J 4536, both at \$5200. Repeat customer Stovall Farms, Mississippi, took home Lot 164, MCBEEF BUILDER F2 474P 3638 at \$4800.

67 % of the bulls went to new customers and 33% sold to repeat customers.

In the female portion of the sale, top selling purebred pair sold to new customer, Robert Eades, Arkansas, for \$3900. She was Lot 201, MCB MS 8018 K101 3030, a Fullblood daughter of MCB MR 440P 8018 and out of a FB C102 daughter with a F1 heifer calf. Lot 200, polled purebred daughter of RJB MR Y296 with a F1 heifer calf went to new buyer David Courson, Illinois, for \$3800 and Lot 202, MCB MS 304W 8148 3034 a PB polled daughter of 304W with a F1 bull calf at side went to new buyer Dennis Ring, Missouri, for \$3800. Top selling Purebred bred heifers were Lot 219, MCB MS 440P 0114 3155, going to new customer Sam Lee, Oklahoma, for \$3100, and Lot 216, MCB MS 6219 8003 3144, going to David Courson, Illinois, for \$3000.

Top McBeef Builder Hybrid pair was Lot 220, MCBEEF BUILDER F2 8384 3547 with a F2 Hybrid bull calf at side for \$4200, going to repeat customer, Terry Entwisle, Illinois. The 26 head of McBeef Builder

Hybrid fall bred heifers went to 6 different buyers for an average of \$3253. New customer, Kelly Mahler, Texas, took home 17 head. New customer Jeffrey Black, Kansas, took 5 head. Repeat buyer Troy Schmidt, Missouri, took 2 head. New buyer Dennis Ring, Missouri, took 1 head and repeat customer Boulden Farms, Missouri, took home 1 head.

90% of the females went to new buyers and 10% sold to repeat customers.

Volume buyers were Kelly Mahler, Texas, with 1 bull and 17 females, Missouri Valley Commission Company and Boulden Farms, Missouri, with 6 bulls, David Courson, Illinois, with 1 bull and 4 females, Jeffrey Black, Kansas, with 5 females, Olson Ranch, Kansas, with 3 bulls and Dakota Wells, Missouri, with 3 bulls. .
